Pediatric Doses for Common Over-the-Counter Medicines

Medication	Usage	Dosage	Frequency	BABY ALERTS
(OVER-THE-COUNTER)	(GIVE FOR)	(HOW MUCH MEDICINE TO GIVE)	(When to Give)	
Acetaminophen (Tylenol) 160mg per teaspoon	Minor aches Minor pain Fever	6-11 lbs	Every 4 hours	Babies who are 2 months of age or younger should be evaluated for any fever over 99.0 degrees axillary (under the armpit). If baby appears ill – tired or sluggish, has a rash or is not eating or drinking
IBUPROFEN (ADVIL OR MOTRIN) 100mg per teaspoon	Minor aches Minor pain Fever	Not recommended for Children less than 6 months old 12-17 lbs 50 mg 1/2 teaspoon 18-23 lbs 75 mg 3/4 teaspoon 24-35 lbs 100 mg 1 teaspoon 36-47 lbs 150 mg 1 1/2 teaspoons 48-59 lbs 200 mg 2 teaspoons 60-71 lbs 250 mg 2 1/2 teaspoons 72-95 lbs 300 mg 3 teaspoons	Every 6-8 hours	- they should be evaluated.
